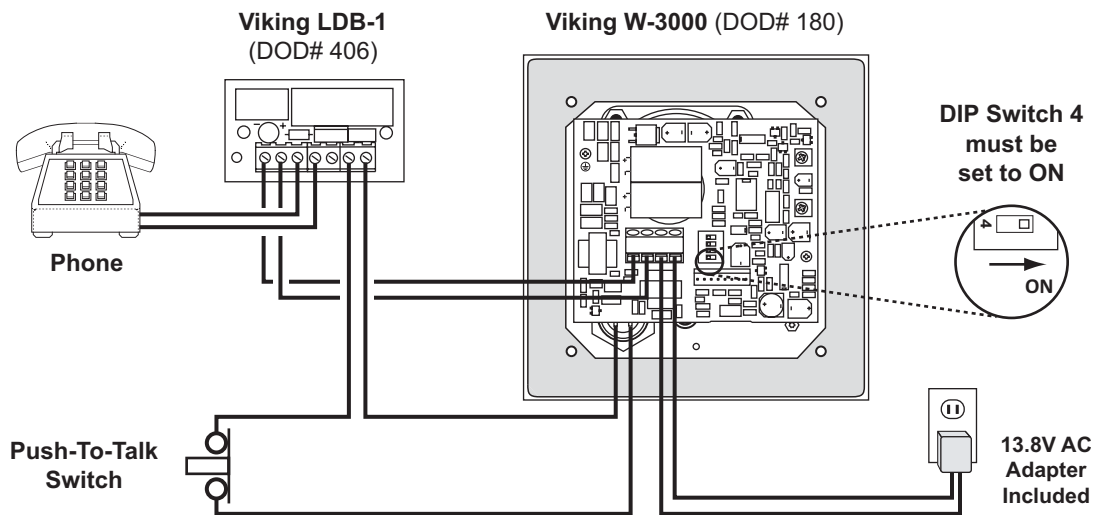


Intercom for drive up or noisy applications

Background noise can interfere with the ability of a handsfree intercom to switch between speaker and microphone. The W-3000, LDB-1 and a normally closed switch can be combined to provide an intercom that will work properly in a noisy environment. The speaker/microphone switching of the W-3000 is controlled by a "push to talk" switch. The microphone of the W-3000 is heard until the receiving end holds the push to talk switch to talk over the W-3000 speaker.

If ring from the call button of the W-3000 is not required because a W-3005 is used or a separate video camera is installed at the intercom, the LDB-1 is not required (wire direct from the W-3000 to the phone).
