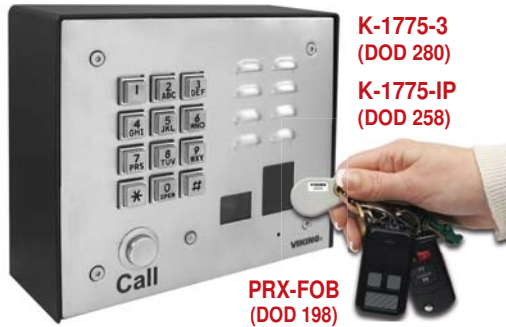

SPOTLIGHT: School Safety & Security

Schools today face increasing risks of violent attacks from students, parents, and other individuals. To keep students and staff safe you must reinforce and secure all entrance doors, limit building access, expand the number of emergency devices, and provide critical instructions to building occupants in the event of an emergency. Viking leads the way in producing economical door entry and access control systems, emergency phones, and mass notification announcers.

After you've increased door security, install a door entry system. Viking door entry products feature real-time video imaging and hands free communication to help you identify visitors and remotely open doors and gates over your existing phone system.



Next, equip faculty and students with proximity ID cards or fobs. Access control with proximity devices allows you to restrict or revoke building access. The ability to immediately revoke access is critical to preventing violent incidents by terminated employees or suspended students.

Then install emergency phones near the restrooms, cafeteria, gymnasium, locker rooms, and in hallways. Conveniently placed emergency phones save critical time when reporting an emergency. In addition to the initial reporting, Viking emergency phones also allow authorities to continually monitor the situation, even if the original caller isn't present. Don't depend on faculty or student cell phones during an emergency. Overloaded cell towers and low signal strength can hamper emergency communications.

Finally, building occupants need up-to-the-second emergency instructions. Installing a mass notification announcer allows you to broadcast instructions throughout the building using your existing paging system. A mass notification announcer allows you to choose from pre-recorded messages or provide a live broadcast from any phone - even from a remote cellphone or landline.

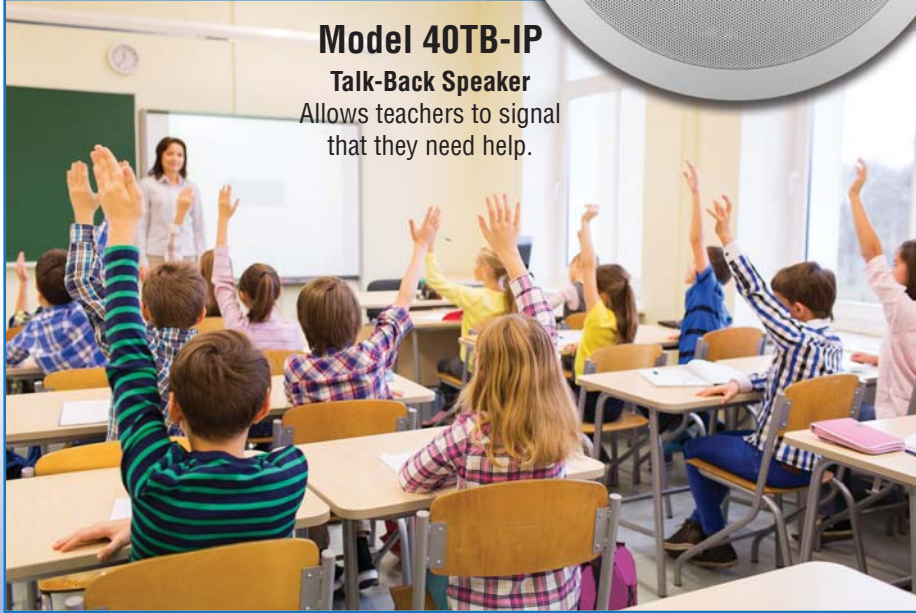

Allows teachers to signal that they need help.



Unfortunate events, like school shootings and spontaneous outbursts, put students and teachers in danger. Establishing a safer environment by providing an easy method for teachers to signal for help is a starting point to help reduce violent situations.

To make an emergency call, simply hold the button for 3 seconds.

Viking's BTR-3 can be used as a panic button to trigger model 40TB-IP SIP Talk-Back Speaker. A momentary center button press of the BTR-3 will initiate a standard call, and holding the button for 3 or more seconds will initiate an emergency call via the 40TB-IP. Thus providing an easy way for teachers to signal for help.

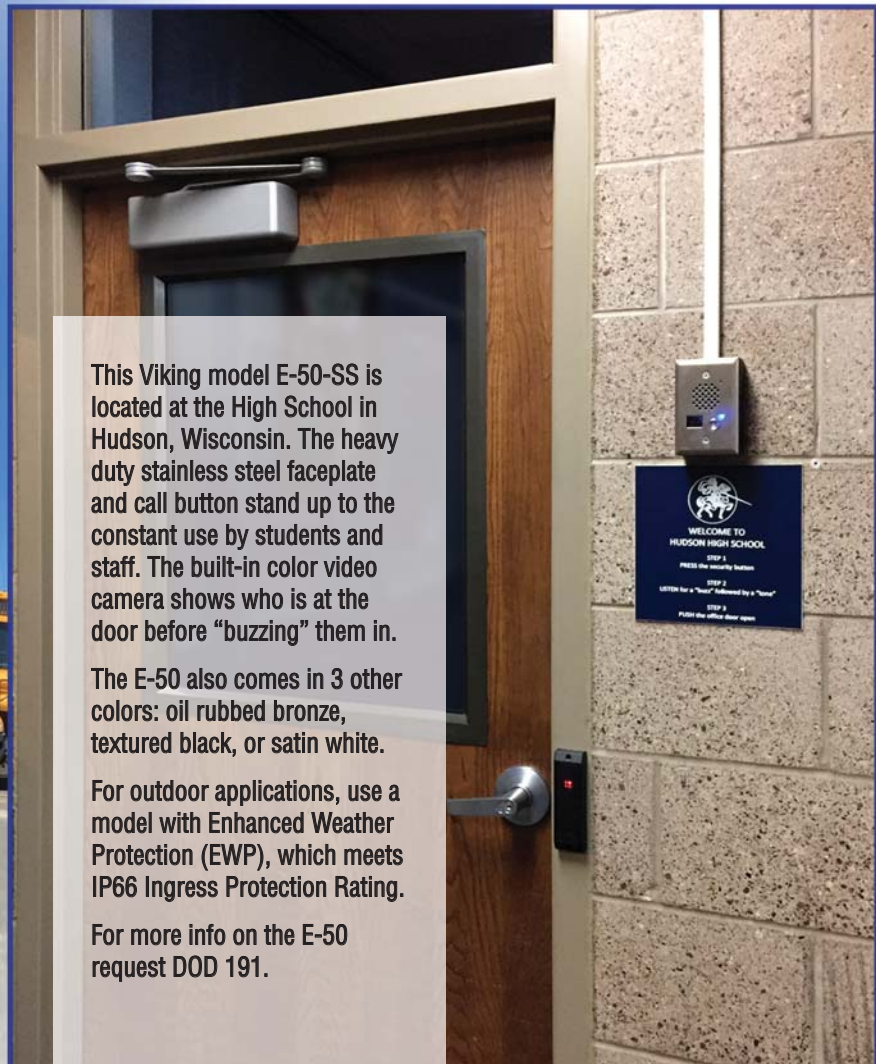

This Viking model E-50-SS is located at the High School in Hudson, Wisconsin. The heavy duty stainless steel faceplate and call button stand up to the constant use by students and staff. The built-in color video camera shows who is at the door before "buzzing" them in.

The E-50 also comes in 3 other colors: oil rubbed bronze, textured black, or satin white.

For outdoor applications, use a model with Enhanced Weather Protection (EWP), which meets IP66 Ingress Protection Rating.

Add Mass Notification to Your Existing Paging System

The DNA-510 is a digital mass notification announcer, that provides up to 2 minutes of recorded voice emergency instructions and alert tones over your existing paging system.



The DNA-510 connects to a phone line, analog phone system station or an unused trunk/line input allowing you to securely page, trigger emergency messages and/or alert tones and program the unit from any remote touch tone phone.

When activated, the DNA-510 will interrupt any current paging or background music and inject an emergency voice message and/or alert tone over your paging system. A live page can also be announced.

Provide LED Strobe / Beacon Visual Indication



The BLK-4 provides high visibility indication of line status through a high powered 360° LED strobe and/or beacon visual indicator. The BLK-4 can be used to add emergency notification to pre-existing emergency phones by turning on the strobe light when the emergency phone is in use.

The included control module can be installed on any standard telephone line or analog PABX/KSU station. The strobe can also be triggered by the relay contact output of the 1600-IP series emergency phones.

The BLK-4 is designed for indoor applications. The BLK-4-EWP is equipped with Enhanced Weather Protection (EWP) for outdoor installations where the unit is exposed to precipitation or condensation.

Generate Multiple Tones for a Paging System

Model MTG-10 is a multi-tone generator designed to add multiple contact-controlled audio tones to paging systems or 600 Ohm inputs. Select from 15 different tones!

The MTG-10 can be connected to a paging source, phone system's paging port or background music. When a contact closure is provided to one of the inputs, the paging or background music is faded out and the appropriate tone is generated over the paging system. The siren and the evacuation whoop have priority and override any other tone.

The MTG-10 can be configured to provide a tone every 15 seconds to notify callers that the call is being recorded. Power supply included.
