




SPOTLIGHT: IP Panel Phones

Vandal Resistant VoIP Panel Phones Includes Auto Dialer and Relay Control

The K-1900-6-IP and K-1900-7-IP VoIP Panel Phones can be programmed to auto-dial a phone number each time the handset is lifted. If the call is not answered, the phone will dial up to 4 additional phone numbers. The K-1900-6-IP and K-1900-7-IP phones are designed to provide quick and reliable communication for SIP VoIP phone systems with PoE. The unit can be programmed from any PC on the same LAN or remotely using a Static IP Address.

The K-1900-8-IP VoIP panel phone can either auto-dial a phone number each time the handset is lifted, be used as a multi-number auto-dialer, or be used as a standard manual dial phone. The phone is designed to provide quick and reliable communication for SIP VoIP phone systems with PoE. The K-1900-8-IP can be programmed from any PC on the same LAN or remotely using a Static IP Address. The K-1900-8-IP phone can dial up to 250 programmable numbers and another 250 rollover numbers.

Pedestal Options for Your Viking Panel Phone



The VE-GNP gooseneck pedestals are designed to be used with any of the VE-Series Surface Mount Boxes (opposite page) and are ideal for drive up communications. The VE-GNP model is a standard 42" gooseneck pedestal, and the VE-GNP-2 can mount two Viking products at different heights. Mounting a Viking panel phone in a surface mount box to the top gooseneck makes it easy for tall vehicles (like semi trucks) to communicate. Mounting a standard Viking call box to the lower gooseneck is great for communication from a car.


Help Stop Vandalism on Your Viking Panel Phone

If you're installing a Viking panel phone in an area with a history of vandalism, you should consider ordering a custom panel phone with our 18" heavy duty armored handset cable and an internal stainless steel lanyard.

The built in lanyard tethers the handset to a steel clamp on the panel phone, making it a much stronger armored cable. The panel phone looks the same as a standard model, except for a shorter handset cable length.

This special handset cable can be ordered on most Viking panel phones.




